



USEFUL INFORMATION & CUSTOMS REGULATION

COUNTRY

NEW CALEDONIA

Documents needed for the Customs Clearance of Household Goods

- Packing list
- Copy of valid passport
- Original bill of lading (no express release accepted) / AWB
- Original inventory in French dated, valued and signed by the shipper
- Invoices for the electrical and hi-fi appliances, valuable furniture, silverware, music instruments (Declaration on the honor with year of purchase)
- For the Territory residents, the shipper has to apply for a franchise to the Customs Head office, explaining why they bring back their belongings:
 - 1- Death: certificate
 - 2- Succession: notarial act + death certificate
 - 3- Marriage: certificate + list of presents (if possible)
 - 4- Other

Customs Regulations

The calculation of taxes is made on the value of purchase (V.A.T. excluded) + sea freight.
Taxes range between 27.25% to 60%

For instance:

- Computer > 32.25% + freight
- Refrigerator > 32.25% + freight
- Bed > 41.25% + freight
- Wine > 44.25% + 30.5 F/L + 10% + 4 F/L+ freight

CAUTION: Property delay runs for 3 months between the boarding date of the effects and the date of arrival of the shipper in the Territory.

- Non Sale delay: 5 years
- For non UE countries, property delay: 18 months

Prohibited Articles

- Firearms, ammunitions are submitted to authorization from the territorial administration: DiRAG - Service Armes et Munitions / BP C5 98844 Noumea Cedex.
- Unlawful drugs

Items excluded from the franchise appliance: alcoholic beverages / tobacco / vehicles and materials for professional use.

Motor Vehicles

• Documents needed • Customs Regulations

- Original bill of lading / AWB
- Original registration card
- Title certificate (certificat de non gage)
- Certificate of change of residence
- Original purchase invoice
- For the Territory residents, shippers have to apply for a franchise to the Customs Head office, explaining why they bring back their vehicle.

Examples of taxes:

Vehicle < 2 500cc: 27.25% for EU vehicle / 42.25% for non EU

Vehicle > 2 500cc: 34.25% (EU) / 49.25% (non EU)

Professional vehicle: 15.25% (EU) / 25.5% (non EU)

CAUTION: Property delay runs for 18 months between the boarding date of the car and the date of arrival of the shipper in the Territory.

Non Sale delay: 5 years

Within 5 years, the shipper will have to pay the taxes fixed by AGS and the customs when the car enter into New Caledonia.
